

## Wayne Central schools head resigns at meeting

The Wayne Central School District superintendent has resigned, district officials announced late Thursday.

Superintendent Mathis Calvin and the district's Board of Education have entered "a mutual separation agreement" effective June 30, officials said. Calvin has led the district since 2015.

In a statement, a district spokesperson said, "The district is thankful for the tireless efforts of Dr. Calvin throughout his tenure at Wayne," and that they wish him well as he moves forward with his career. Calvin said he submitted his resignation with mixed emotions, and did not cite a reason for his departure. Vicma Ramos, the superintendent and chief executive officer for the Wayne-Finger Lakes Board of Cooperative Educational Services, will serve as the district's interim superintendent starting July 1, said district spokeswoman Amy Gebhardt. The resignation occurred at the board's regular meeting Thursday evening.
