

Brighton HS principal Hall named best in NY

Brighton High School's Tom Hall has been named the top high school principal in New York by the School Administrators Association of New York State, the school announced this week.

Hall has been principal at Brighton High School since 2012, but began his career there as a biology teacher in 1996. He is also former principal at French Road Elementary School.
