

Man fired, accused of touching

Bus driver loses his job over recent allegations

An East Irondequoit bus driver has been fired after allegations that he inappropriately touched a high school student on his run. Renaldo Vega, 44, of Rochester was terminated by the East Irondequoit School District, according to a news release from the Irondequoit Police Department.

On Dec. 10, the police became aware of possible inappropriate behavior between Vega and a student passenger on a bus route that Vega took over last month. An investigation revealed that Vega had befriended the student and touched the student on several occasions during a bus run, police said. The school district suspended Vega upon learning of the allegations and fired him on Monday. He was arrested on three counts of forcible touching and endangering the welfare of a child. He was arraigned on Monday in Irondequoit Town Court.
