

ER names 3 finalists for superintendent

The East Rochester school district has narrowed its field down to three candidates in the search for a new superintendent.

The finalists are Mathis Calvin, a former Rochester teacher who is currently superintendent in the Stockbridge Valley Central School District in Madison County; Christopher Dailey, currently superintendent of the Batavia City School District; and Mark Linton, principal of Geneseo Elementary School. The three men are seeking to replace Richard Stutzman, who is serving as interim superintendent. The new leader should be in place for the 2015-16 school year.
