

Rush-Henrietta coach/ science teacher arrested

A teacher and swim coach from the Rush-Henrietta Central School District has been arrested on unspecified charges related to an investigation into the use of a small room adjacent to a changing room used by female students, the district announced on Sunday.

According to the district, a staff member at Rush-Henrietta Senior High School recently reported concerns about the room to school and district officials, sparking an internal investigation. On Dec. 4, the district notified the Monroe County Sheriff's Office.

Science teacher Matt Greene was arrested as a result of the police investigation, according to the district. Greene, who also works as a swim coach for both the boys and girls teams, has been placed on administrative leave and is prohibited from visiting school district grounds.

The school district is asking anyone with information related to the investigation to call 911.
