

Teamsters in Greece district ratify contract

Teamsters in the Greece Central School District may have a new fouryear contract.

The contract was ratified after 15 months of negotiations, according to a statement from Teamsters Local 118.

The school board is expected to vote on the contract in July, according to district spokeswoman Laurel Heiden.

The finalized agreement would provide annual wage increases and is expected to stabilize health care costs and increase comp time and bereavement leave, among other changes, according to Chris Toole, Local 118 Secretary- Treasurer and lead negotiator.

The union represents bus drivers, food service employees, teaching assistants and teacher aides, facility operations staff, security guards and some clerical staff.
